

BAYAMON | PR Despite the proven superiority of mitral repair over replacement

for degenerative mitral disease, mitral valve replacement remains common. Guidelines now recommend referral of patients to valve centers of excellence or reference centers. Recently, the leading American (ACC, AHA, STS, AATS) and European (ESC, EACTS) scientific organizations have defined mitral centers of excellence as centers in which the likelihood of successful and durable repair exceeds 95% with an operative mortality risk of less than 1%. That is what we are now offering in Puerto Rico at Bayamon Medical Center.

We continue to encourage patients to learn more about signs and symptoms of heart valve disease. Our brochures inform about

screening and importance of cardiac auscultation. You need an echocardiogram if you have a heart murmur (soplo cardíaco), shortness of breath (dificultad para respirar), weakness or dizziness (debilidad o mareo), chest pain or discomfort (dolor o presión en el pecho), fainting (desmayos), fatigue (fatiga), rapid or irregular heartbeat (arritmias), swollen abdomen or ankles and feet (hinchazón de abdomen, tobillos o pies).




