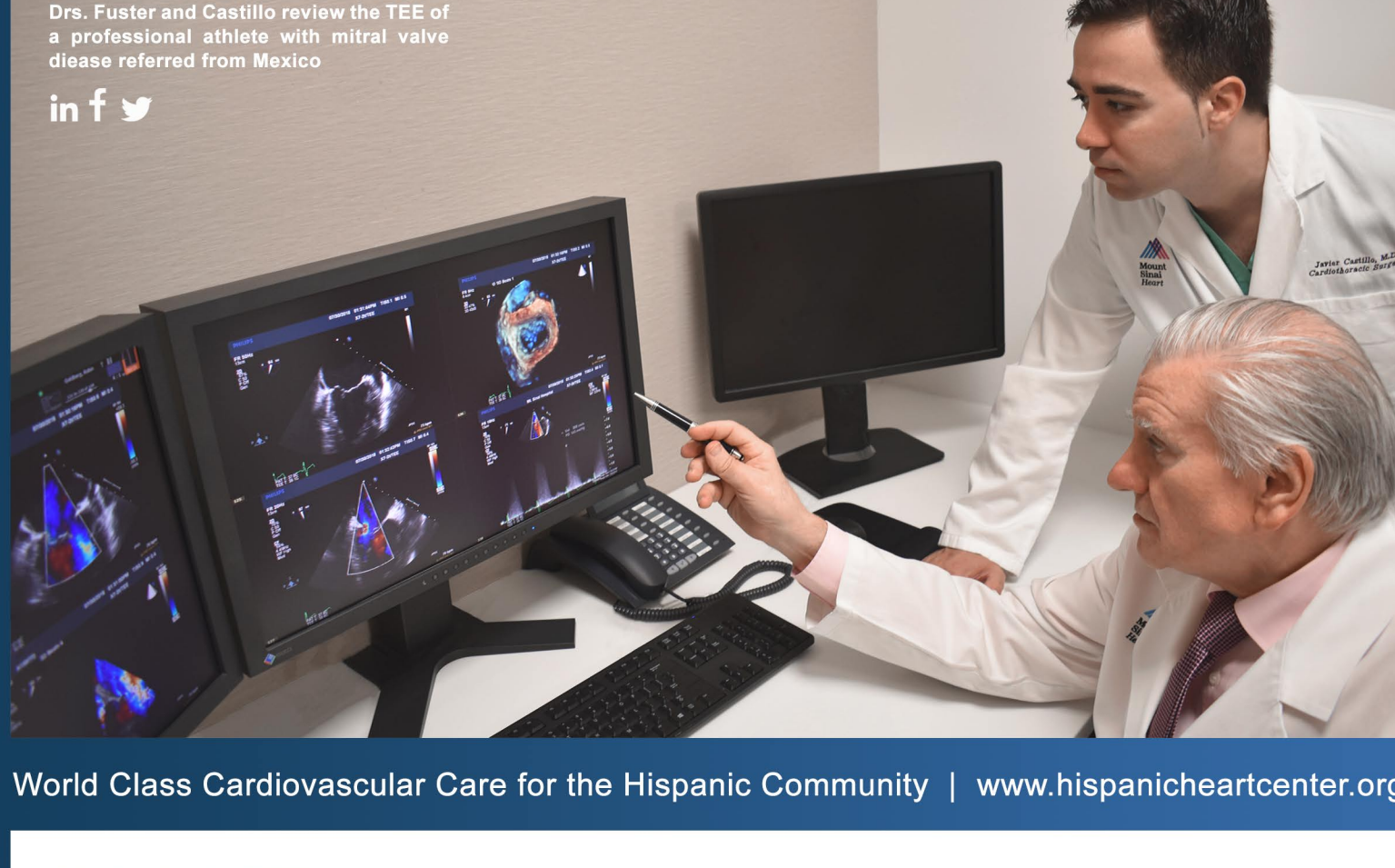
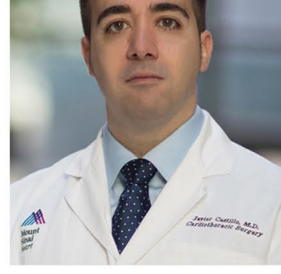

XXVII Encuentro Internacional de Cardiología

JULY 25, 2018 | LEON, MEXICO

The XXVII International Meeting of the ANCCMR, one of the
largest cardiovascular societies in Mexico, was held on July 26,
2018 in Leon. Over 2900 attendees from 11 countries, including
internists, cardiologists, cardiovascular surgeons, and exhibitors
were in attendance. Dr. Javier Castillo, Director of the Hispanic
Heart Center, led the plenary session on current management of
mitral valve disease. In addition, a debate on patient selection in
the setting of mitral valve disease and severe left ventricular
dysfunction took place. This session was the most attended of the
conference.

The 2018 Hispanic Heart Center Symposium on Structural Heart
Disease will be held at the Mitral Foundation Center - The Mount
Sinai Hospital - on November 2. The theme of the conference is

Excellence* and it wishes to stress the need for early recognition
of valve disease. Furthermore, an emphasis on establishing how
and when to escalate level of care (referral pattern and network)
will be made. Local speakers and delegates are expected to
represent a multidisciplinary league of professionals who manage
patients with heart valve disease in the Hispanic community.

Need an echocardiogram if you have:

- . A heart murmur
- . Shortness of breath
- . Weakness or dizziness
- . Chest pain, tightness, or discomfort
- . Fainting or feeling faint
- . Fatigue
- . Rapid or irregular heartbeat
- . Lightheadedness
- . Decrease in exercise capacity
- . Swollen abdomen or ankles and feet

- . Un soplo cardíaco
- . Falta de aire o dificultad para respirar
- . Debilidad o siente vértigo
- . Dolor o presión en el pecho
- . Desmayos o siente que se va desmayar
- . Fatiga

- . Limitaciones en la actividad física
- . Hinchazón de abdomen, tobillos o pies

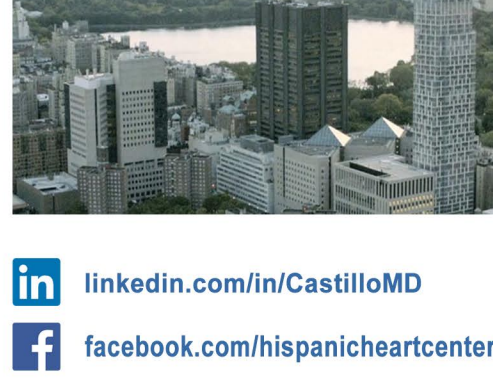
